

Project Management, Engineering and Technical Roles Pay & Benefits Survey



In October 2016 we conducted our annual project management, engineering and technical roles pay and benefits survey.

The survey covers **43 different infrastructure / construction levels** and reports data on base pay, bonuses, allowances and other benefits, with data cuts provided by discipline, sector, location and tenure.

Here are the main 3 headline findings from this year's survey.

The overall picture is one of cautious upward movement in base pay, potentially due to economic uncertainty in the aftermath of Brexit.

Base pay increases were on average 1.88% from last year	Actual bonus payouts are overall <i>almost half</i> that of target levels	Benefit levels and practices generally remain consistent with last year, with a trend developing towards more wellbeing and time off benefits.
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Participation continues to grow, with 16 organisations taking part in 2016, forming a **community of Infrastructure and Construction organisations** involved in **regular information sharing and networking events** throughout the year.
